History of the Institution

Baratiya Vidya Bhavan is a Registered society and a Charitable Trust founded in 1938 by **Dr K M Munshi**, a far-sighted visionary and a practical idealist, along with three of his close associates with the blessings of Mahatama Gandhi to preserve and propagate Sanskrit, the mother of languages. It had the privilege of association of distinguished Freedom fighters and leaders of pre-independence and post-independence India such as Dr Rajendra Prasad, the first President of India, Pt. Jawahar Lal Nehru, the first Prime Minister of India, Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, the first Home Minister of India, Shri C Rajagopalachari and others.

Over the years the Bhavan has steadily grown into a comprehensive, co-operative national movement, with an international outlook, for the promotion of ethical and spiritual values and Indian cultural heritage in the last 78 years through its 367 institutions across India and 7 centers abroad, staff strength of over 6000 and student base of about 3,00,000; it is probably the largest Non-governmental and Charitable organization in the country.

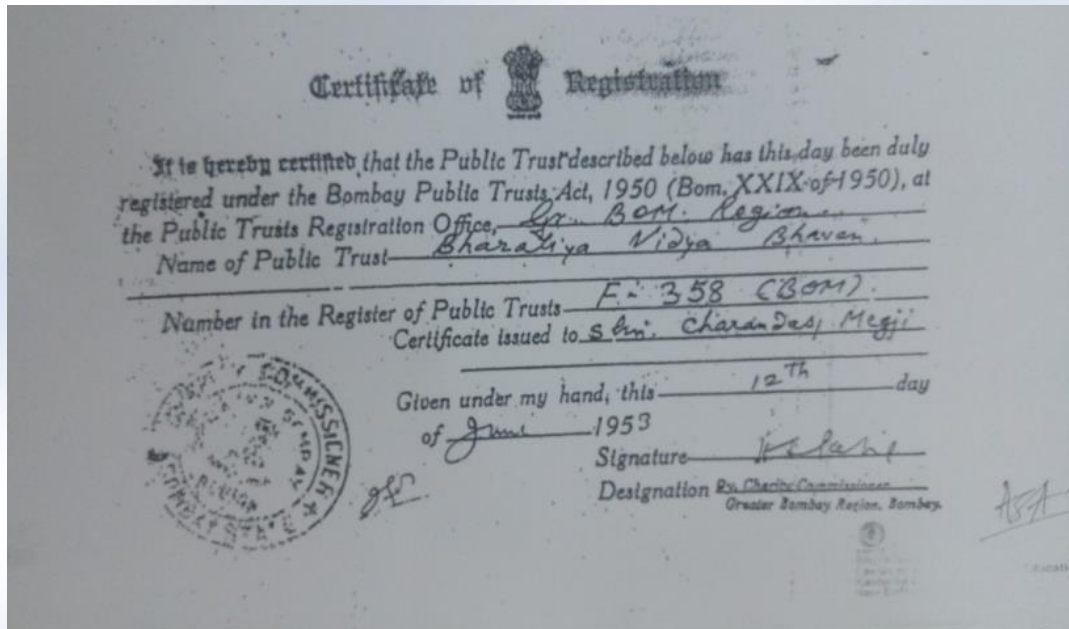

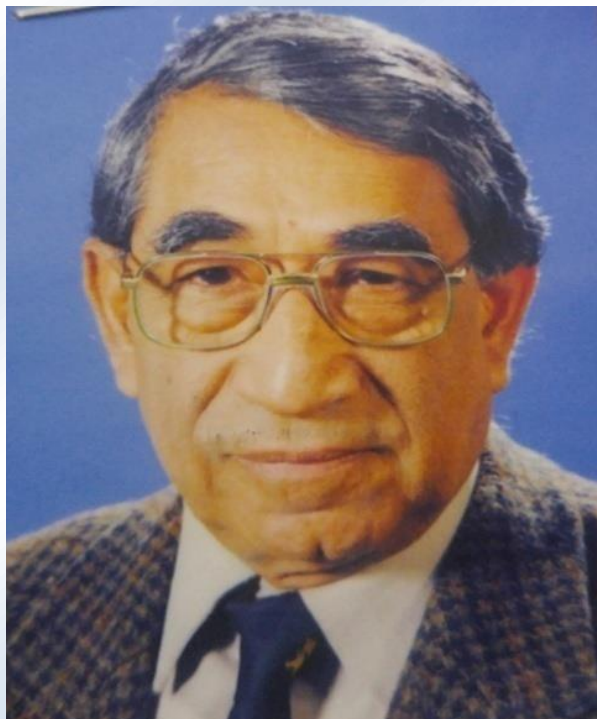



RECOGNITION ORDER

2. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny/perusal, veracity of the facts & figures as per the application submitted by the institutions mentioned in table below, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of visiting team report including videography and also the reply submitted by the institution against decision of clause 7(13) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014, the Northern Regional Committee in its meeting held from time to time (mentioned against each of the institution) is satisfied that the institution/society fulfils the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the concerned Teacher Education Programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory, etc. for running the programme and has selected/appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms and as per the approval of faculty given by the affiliating bodies.

3. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a)/15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition/permission to the following Institutions for conducting Teacher Education programme with an annual intake mentioned against their names from the academic session 2016-2017 under clause 7(16) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014 subject to fulfilment of the conditions mentioned below:-

4. The institutions shall adhere to the fulfillment of the provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 and ensure the following before commencement of the session:-

**NORMS AND STANDARDS FOR BACHELOR OF EDUCATION PROGRAMME LEADING TO THE
BACHELOR OF EDUCATION (B.ED.) DEGREE – Regarding Staff**

5.1 Academic Faculty

For an intake of two basic units of 50 students each, that is total students strength of 200, there shall 16 full-time faculty members.

The distribution of faculty across different curricular areas shall be as under:

- Note: (i) The faculty positions listed under different subject categories may teach course(s) in the Teacher Education Programme across curricular areas specified, and can cater to both foundation and pedagogy course(s). If the students strength for two years is one hundred (with one basic unit) only, the number of faculty shall be reduced to 8.
- (ii) Faculty can be utilized teaching in flexible manner so as to optimize academic expertise available.

5.2 Qualifications

The faculty shall possess the following qualifications:

A. Principal / HOD

- (i) Postgraduate degree in Arts / Sciences / Social Sciences / Humanities/Commerce with minimum 55% marks; and
- (ii) M.Ed. with minimum 55% marks; and
- (iii) Ph.D in Education or in any pedagogic subject offered in the institutions; and
- (iv) Eight years of teaching experience in a secondary Teacher Education Institution.

Desirable : Diploma/Degree in Education Administration or Educational Leadership.

B. Perspectives in Education or Foundation Courses

- (i) Postgraduate degree in Social Sciences with minimum 55% marks; and M.Ed. degree from a recognized university with minimum 55% marks.

OR

Postgraduate (MA) degree in Education with minimum 55% marks; and

- (i) B.Ed./B.El.Ed. degree with minimum 55% marks.

C. Curriculum and Pedagogic Courses

- (i) Postgraduate degree in Sciences / Mathematics /Social Sciences/Languages with minimum 55% marks; and M.Ed. degree minimum 55% marks

Desirable : PhD degree in Education with subject specialisations.

[Note : In case of B and C put together, for two faculty positions, a postgraduate degree in Sociology/Psychology/Philosophy with 55% marks, and B.Ed. /B.El.Ed. with 55% marks and three years of teaching experience in a secondary school shall be considered].

- D. Specialised Courses Physical Education
- (i) Master of Physical Education (M.P.Ed.) with minimum 55% marks. (Training/qualification in yoga education shall be desirable)
- Visual Arts
- Post graduate degree in Fine Arts (MFA) with minimum 55% marks

5.4 Terms and conditions Service

The terms and conditions of service of teaching and non-teaching staff including selection procedure, pay scales, age of superannuation and other benefits shall be as per the policy of the State Government/Affiliating body.

4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc. as applicable and compliance of the following by the affiliating body, State Govt and also the concerned recognised Institution:-

- (i) The affiliating bodies/State Govt. shall be required to verify the authenticity of the land & building documents with the required land & built up area as well as appointment of requisite teaching & non-teaching staff as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 by the concerned institution before grant of affiliation to an institution.
- (ii) The affiliating body shall ensure that the institution is composite institution as per the definition of composite institution given in the NCTE Regulation, 2014. If at any stage, it is found that the institution as not a composite institution, the recognition, granted will be treated as withdrawn and the sole responsibility of the same will be of the institution. However, in the existing institutions permitted for additional intake, shall have to ensure that they are to become composite gradually preferably the academic session 2016-17.
- (iii) The NOC of the affiliating body and staff approval thereof submitted by the institution, if found fake at any stage, the recognition, granted will be treated as withdrawn and the sole responsibility of the same will be of the institution.

5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

6. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-

- (i) Copy of the Application Form
- (ii) Land and Building Particulars




- (iii) Staff Profile
- (iv) Recognition letter
- (v) Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

7. In case if the land is in the name of the Society/trust, the land is to be transferred within six months in the name of the institution, failing which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate about the same to the respective Regional Committee along with the new land documents within the stipulated time.

8. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

9. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the order, it may prefer an appeal under sections 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 in the "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte.india.org within 60 days from the date of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.

THIS INDENTURE made the 13th day of April 1960 between the President of the Society of the one part,

AX. M. Munshi, (2) Smt. Lilavati Munshi, Bhardhari Lal Mehta, (4) Shri B.P. Singh Roy, Krishna Kumar Birla, (6) Shri Damodar Dass Khanna, and Bishambhar Nath Chaturvedi, all Trustees of the Bhartiya Van, Delhi Branch, a society registered under the Registration Act (XXI of 1860) and having its office at Delhi (hereinafter called the lessee), on the one part, and the Government of India relating to Delhi, the Chief Commissioner of Delhi, on the other part, do hereby demise the plot of land hereinafter described to the Lessee.

WITNESSETH that in consideration of Rs. 6500/- (Rupees Six thousand & five hundred only) paid before the execution of these presents (the receipt whereof the Lessor hereby acknowledges and of the rent hereinafter reserved and of the covenants on the part of the Lessee hereinafter contained the Lessor doth hereby demise unto the Lessee ALL THAT plot of land containing by admeasurement 1.3 acres or thereabouts situated at Curzon Road, New Delhi in the site acquired for the erection of the New Capital of Delhi which said plot of land is more particularly described in the schedule hereunder written and with the boundaries thereof has for greater clearness been delineated on the plan annexed to these presents and thereon coloured red TOGETHER with all rights, easements and appurtenances whatsoever to the said plot of land belonging or appertaining TO HOLD the premises hereby demised unto the Lessee in perpetuity from the 17th day of January, 1952 YIELDING AND PAYING therefor the yearly rent payable in advance of Rs. 325.00 (Rupees Three hundred & twenty five only) or such other sum as may hereafter be assessed under the covenants and conditions hereinafter contained clear of all deductions by equal half-yearly payments on the fifteenth day of January and fifteenth day of July in each year at the Imperial Bank of India, New Delhi, or at such other place as may be notified by the Chief Commissioner of Delhi for this purpose, from time to time, the first of such payments to be made on the fifteenth day of July 1952.

Subject always to the exceptions, reservations, conditions and covenants hereinafter contained, that is to say, as follows :-

1. The Lessor excepts and reserves unto himself all mines, minerals, coals, goldwashing, earth oils, stone, gravel and quarries in or under the said land, and full right and power at all times to do all acts and things necessary and expedient for the purpose of working the said mines, minerals, coals, goldwashing, earth oils, stone, gravel and quarries.

the same without providing or leaving any vertical support for the surface of the said land or for any building for the time being standing thereon provided always that the Lessor shall make reasonable compensation to the Lessee for all damage directly occasioned by the exercise of the rights hereby reserved or any of them.

2. The Lessee for himself, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns covenant with the Lessor in manner following (that is to say) :—

- (1) The Lessee will pay unto the Lessor the yearly rent thereby reserved on the days and in the manner hereinbefore appointed without any deduction.
- (2) The Lessee will from time to time and at all times pay and discharge all rates, taxes, charges and assessments of every description which are now or may at any time hereafter during the continuation of this lease be assessed, charged or imposed upon the premises hereby demised or on any building to be erected thereupon or on the Landlord or Tenant in respect thereof.
- (3) All arrears of rent and other payments due in respect of the premises hereby demised shall be recoverable in the same manner as arrears of land revenue under the provisions of the Punjab Land Revenue Act, XVII of 1887, and any amending Act for the time being in force.
- (4) The Lessee will in all respects comply with and be bound by the building drainage and other bye-laws for the time being in force in the New Capital of Delhi.
- (5) The Lessee will not without the previous consent in writing of the Chief Commissioner of Delhi or of such officers or body as the Lessor or the Chief Commissioner of Delhi may authorise in this behalf make any alterations in or additions to the buildings erected on the said demised premises so as to affect any of the architectural or structural features thereof or erect or suffer to be erected on any part of the said demised premises any buildings other than and except the buildings erected thereon at the date of these presents.
- (6) The Lessee shall not without the written consent of the Chief Commissioner construct any well of any description, or instal any private system of supplying water whether for irrigation or for drinking.
- (7) The Lessee will not without such consent as aforesaid carry on or permit to be carried on on the said premises any trade or business whatsoever or use the same or permit the same to be used for any purpose other than that of ~~a~~ Bhavan's 2 or do or suffer to be done thereon any act or thing whatsoever which in the opinion of the Chief Commissioner of Delhi may be an annoyance or disturbance to the President in Council or his tenants in the New Capital of Delhi.
- (8) Any servants' quarters constructed by the Lessee shall not without the written permission of the Chief Commissioner of Delhi be occupied or permitted to be occupied otherwise than by the bona-fide servants of persons occupying the main building.

PROVIDED also the lessor shall have a pre-emptive right to purchase the demised premises after deducting the amount of the unearned increase as aforesaid.

(15) The said Lessee will not alter, amend or in any other way modify the registered Articles and Memorandum of Association or rules of business etc., (by whatever name the Constitution of the institution is called) or their Constitution or Composition without first obtaining the approval of the Chief Commissioner, Delhi State, to the proposed alterations, amendments or modifications.

If there shall at any time have been in the opinion of the Lessor or the Chief Commissioner of Delhi whose decision shall be final, any breach by the Lessee or by any person claiming through or under him of any of the covenants or conditions contained in sub-clauses (5), (9) and (10) of Clause 2 and if the said intended lessee shall neglect or fail to remedy any such breach to the satisfaction of the Chief Commissioner of Delhi within seven days from the receipt of a Notice signed by the Chief Commissioner of Delhi requiring him to remedy such breach it shall be lawful for the officers and workmen acting under the authority and direction of the Chief Commissioner of Delhi to enter upon the premises hereby demised and (a) to remove or demolish any alterations in or additions to the buildings erected on the said premises, (b) to remove or demolish any building erected on the said premises without the previous consent in writing of the Chief Commissioner of Delhi or duly authorised officer as aforesaid, (c) to fill any excavation or carry out any repairs that may be necessary and all such moneys and expenses as may be laid out and incurred by the Chief Commissioner of Delhi or by his order shall be paid by the said Lessee; and it is hereby expressly declared that the liberty hereinbefore given is not to prejudice in any way the power given to the President in Council by Clauses 4 and 5 hereof.

- (1) The Bhavan shall be at liberty to use the halls, rooms and the theatre for its activities in pursuance of its objectives, if necessary, by charging fees from the audience for admission provided that where any such activity involves the payment of the State Entertainment Tax, exemption for the same has been simultaneously secured on each such occasion when an admission fee is proposed to be charged; and whenever the halls, rooms or theatre are not required by the Bhavan the Bhavan shall be at liberty to charge fees or monetary return for their use or occupation by other parties, provided that such use shall be confined only to clubs, societies or institutions with an object similar to any of the objects of the Bhavan and if the occasion involved the payments of the State Entertainment Tax only when the hirers have secured exemption from the levy of such tax, if the hirers propose to levy an admission fee on the audience; the permission should, in no case, be given to let out the permission to any professional, theatrical or cinematograph company or other professional entertainer, unless the purpose of such letting has been approved by the Chief Commissioner.
- (ii) The Bhavan shall be at liberty to conduct a restaurant or cafeteria on the premises and recover catering charges from those making use of the restaurant or cafeteria, provided that such restaurant or cafeteria, shall be run principally for the benefit of the persons living or working in the premises of attending a function held therein, and it shall not be allowed to develop as a general restaurant for the public.
- (iii) The Bhavan shall be at liberty to let out rooms for temporary use of members of the Bhavan for residential purposes provided that such residents are not permitted to set up any kitchen arrangements independent of the Bhavan's restaurant or cafeteria.
- (iv) Certain portions of the building, as agreed to by the Chief Commissioner prior to construction, may be reserved for the residence of the caretaker and resident officers whose presence on the premises is accepted as necessary by the Chief Commissioner.
- (v) No musical performance will be permitted after 11 p.m.

ALLOTMENT PAPER

Copy of letter No. 9659-W1/51 dated 26-12-1951 from the Under Secretary to the Government of India, Ministry of Works, Housing and Supply to the Chief Commissioner, Delhi, regarding Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan - allotment of land to.

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President to the allotment of a plot of land about one acre on Curzon Road opposite the Constitution Club, to the Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan, on payment of premium at the rate of Rs. 5,000/- per acre, with an annual ground rent of 5% thereon, for constructing a building to carry on the Bhavan's cultural activities. The allotment is subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) The Bhavan shall be at liberty to use the halls, rooms and theatre for its activities in pursuance of its objectives, if necessary, by charging fees from the audience for admission, provided exemption from the levy of the State Entertainment Tax is simultaneously secured on each such occasion when an admission fee is proposed to be charged, and whenever the halls, rooms or theatre are not required by the Bhavan, the Bhavan shall be at liberty to charge for their use by other parties, provided that such use shall be confined only to clubs, societies or educational or charitable associations or artists association and societies, and in case of entertainments only when the hirers have secured exemption from the levy of State Entertainment Tax if the hirers propose to levy an admission fee on the audience; the permission should, in no case, be let out to any professional, theatrical or cinematograph company or other professional entertainer, unless the purpose of such letting has been approved by the Chief Commissioner.
- (ii) The Bhavan shall be at liberty to conduct a restaurant or cafeteria on the premises and recover catering charges from those making use of the restaurant or cafeteria, provided that such restaurant or cafeteria shall be run principally for the benefit of persons living or working on the premises or attending a function held therein, and it shall not be allowed to develop as a general restaurant for the public;
- (iii) The Bhavan shall be at liberty to construct rooms in the building which may be let out to temporary use of members of the Bhavan for residential purposes provided that such residents are not permitted to set up any kitchen arrangements independent of the Bhavan's restaurant or cafeteria;
- (iv) Certain portions of the building, as agreed to by the Chief Commissioner prior to construction, may be reserved for the residence of the caretaker and resident officers whose presence on the premises is accepted as necessary by the Chief Commissioner and
- (v) No musical performance shall be permitted after 11 p.m.

The Bhavan should complete the proposed buildings on the site within 2 years from the date of allotment of the site.
