FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME:

“BALANCING BODY, MIND, AND SPIRIT: A FACULTY DEVELOPMENT JOURNEY”

A 7-day Faculty Development Programme on the theme ‘Balancing Body, Mind, and Spirit: A Faculty Development Journey’ was organized from June 19-26, 2025 within the premises of Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan-Delhi Kendra. The week-long programme offered a transformative exploration of holistic well-being through expert-led sessions.

On June 19th, 2025 Dr. Geetika Dutta, Principal & Dean (Academics), Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan, Delhi Kendra commenced the programme with insights through the session titled ‘Mindful Higher Education’ that blended theory with interactive discussions. The session on June 20th featured discipline-based presentations on Mindful Practices by faculty members, where participants collaboratively explored subject-specific applications of mindfulness in education.

The session on June 23 included a dual focus: Dr. Shalini Gupta, HOD (B.Ed.), BLMCE delved into “Food as Medicine” from an Ayurvedic perspective, guiding participants through a hands-on activity to determine their body type (Vaata, Kapha, Pitta) and design balanced meal plans. Later, Shri K. Siva Prasad, Hon’ble Director, Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan, Delhi Kendra conducted an immensely insightful session on ‘Gita Acharan- A Beginner’s Perspective’ linking selfless action to educational practices. The session also enlightened about the different states of balance in human and the conditions that can hinder it. The ways of recovering balance were also suggested in the session.

The session on June 24th showcased Dr. Shashi Bala (Dean, Center of Indology) in her illuminating session on “Dhyaan”, where she traced the historical evolution of meditation practices from ancient Vedic traditions to Buddhist adaptations.



The session on June 25th featured Dr. Reetu Sharma, HOD (Economics, Commerce and Management), BVBC in her transformative session “The Journey Within: Understanding Your Spiritual Being,” where she guided participants through meditative practices to explore the five koshas (sheaths of the body) and the chakra system, fostering deeper self-awareness. The programme concluded on June 26th with a thought-provoking film screening and discussion that synthesized key themes and sparked deep reflections on integrating holistic approaches into education.

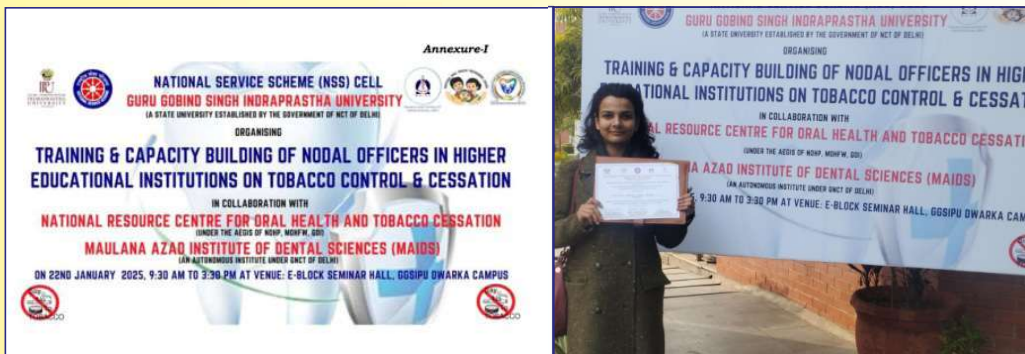
PARTICIPATION IN ANUGOONJ PRELIMS

EDUCATIONAL VISIT TO NATIONAL CRAFT MUSEUM

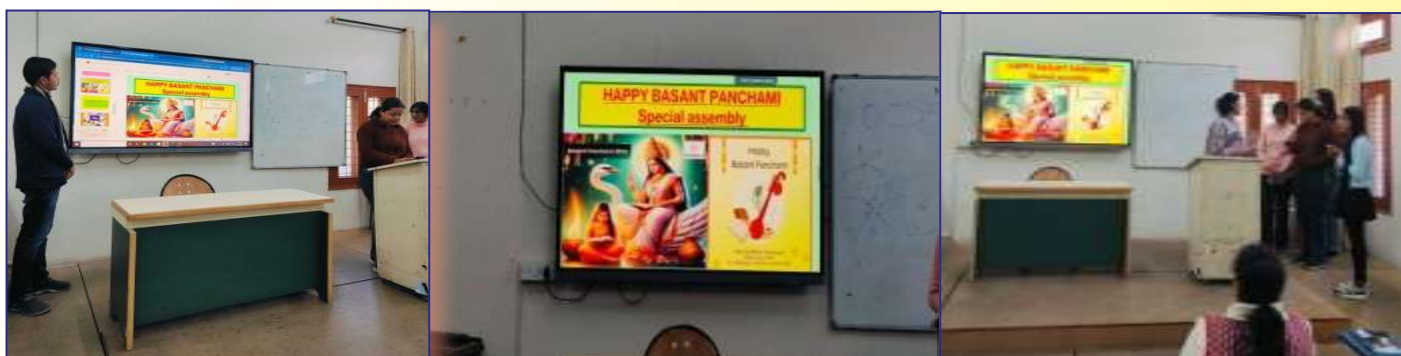

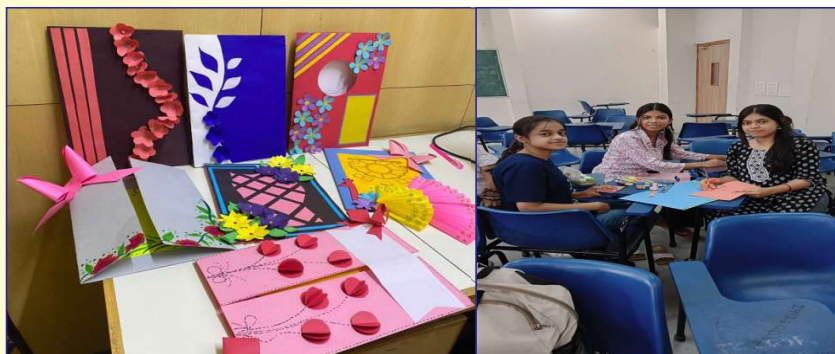


NAVRATRI AND EID CELEBRATIONS
